PAD 205 Introduction to Public Administration 3 Cr

The course focuses on the public sector with specific emphasis on the role of the manager in directing public institutions. Skill development and understanding of policy-making, management, and professional ethics are key course objectives. Designed to prepare students for service at municipal, state, and federal levels of government. Fall semester.

PAD 412 Administrative Internship 3 Cr

An opportunity to apply former course work to administrative responsibilities in a public sector work environment. Prerequisite: Consent of the chairs of the Business, Accounting, and Economics Department and the Political Science Department.
