NS 151 Fundamentals of Physical & Life Science 3 Cr

An introduction and integrated approach to the major principles of physics, chemistry, earth science, astronomy, and life science. Emphasis is placed on the most basic principles of the natural sciences and on applications and implications of those principles to individual daily lives and to societal issues. Non-science students learn to appreciate the scientific process as well as the benefits and problems which scientific advance brings. A rigorous seminar-style course in a liberal arts spirit in which students are expected to conduct library research, prepare in advance for class participation and contribute to class discussion. A one-semester non-lab course offered at the option of the Natural Sciences Department. Meets the college Carroll College Core Curriculum in Natural Science. No prerequisites.
