GK 201-202 Introductory Scriptural Greek 6 Cr

This course is designed to give students an introduction to Koine Greek. Students will develop proficiency in listening, speaking, writing, and especially reading Greek by acquiring linguistic knowledge and skills, understanding of scriptural texts and Christian Greek literature and culture, and analytical language skills that may be applied to English and other languages. Fall odd and spring even semesters.

GK 301-302 Classical Attic Greek 6 Cr

This course is designed to give students an introduction to Classical Attic Greek. Students will develop proficiency in listening, speaking, writing, and especially reading Greek by acquiring linguistic knowledge and skills, understanding of Greek literature and culture and analytical language skills that may be applied to English and other languages. Prerequisite: GK 201-202. Fall even and spring odd semesters.
