David, a native of Helena, just completed his second season as the head coach for the Fighting Saints and has racked up an impressive 29-9-2 record during this time. Thorvilson started his college career at Gonzaga University in Spokane, WA. After two seasons, he transferred to Montana State University Billings to

complete his education and collegiate career. He then became the assistant and goalkeeper coach for both men's and women's teams at MSU-Billings. After two seasons, David ventured to North Dakota and became the graduate assistant at the University of Mary where he earned a Masters of Business Administration and helped both teams earn national tournament bids (men in 2001 and woman in 2002). Thorvilson moved back to Helena in 2003 and became the assistant coach for the Saints for 4 years. David holds coaching licenses from both U.S. Soccer Federation and National Soccer Coaches Association of America.

TRAINING AND SUPERVISION

A certified trainer is on duty at all times. Roll call is taken twice daily. Dormitories are supervised by adult coaches and trainers. In addition, dormitory entrances are staffed 24 hours by campus representatives. Bed check is at 10pm nightly.
