

## Mac OS X (tested with 10.3)

### Connect to CC ResNet

- Click the **Apple** Menu, then click **System Preferences**
  - Click on **Network** in the top row
- In the **Location** drop-down menu, select **New Location...**
  - Type **CC ResNet** in the box
  - In the **Show** drop-down menu, select **Built-in Ethernet**
  - Click on **PPPoE** and put a check in the box **Connect using PPPoE**
  - In the **Service Provider** box type **Carroll College**
  - Type your **username** (e.g. jsmith) in the **Account Name** box
  - Type your **password** in the **Password** box
  - **PPPoE Service Name** - leave it blank
  - **Save password** - do you want your password saved for your connection to the network? If so, check the box, if you'd rather enter your password when you want to connect to the network, uncheck it. Since this is your network login account and password, you may want to leave it unchecked, just so anyone in your room can't use the network with your username...
  - **Show PPPoE status in menu bar** - leave this checked, it puts a little <---> icon in your menu bar that you can click on and quickly connect to or disconnect from the network.
  - Click **Apply Now** and close the window
- There should be a little <---> icon on your menu bar now, click it and a menu will appear, if you didn't save your password in the **Save password** step above, then just click **Connect**, enter your password and you're online, if you did save your password, just click connect. Happy surfing!

### Email: POP3 and IMAP

- Setting up your email client for POP3 or IMAP accounts will vary depending on the software you use.
  - The email server is jude.carroll.edu - use this for both incoming and outgoing email server fields.
  - You must authenticate (enter your username and password) to check your email (incoming).
  - You must authenticate to send email (outgoing SMTP).
  - If you get errors after setting up your email client regarding sending email, please be sure to configure your email client to use your username and password when sending email - this is not always part of the default setup.

### Map your X Drive

- Click the **Go** menu and select **Connect to server...**
  - In the **Server Address:** box, type **smb://mark.carroll.edu/username\$** e.g. **smb://mark.carroll.edu/jsmith\$**
  - Click **Connect**
  - If your username and password have not been saved, enter them here in the **Username** and **Password** fields. Click **OK**.
