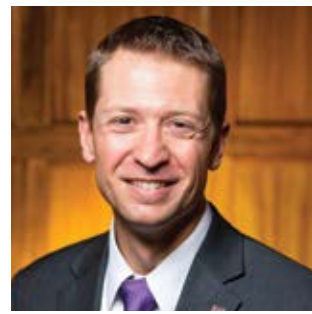

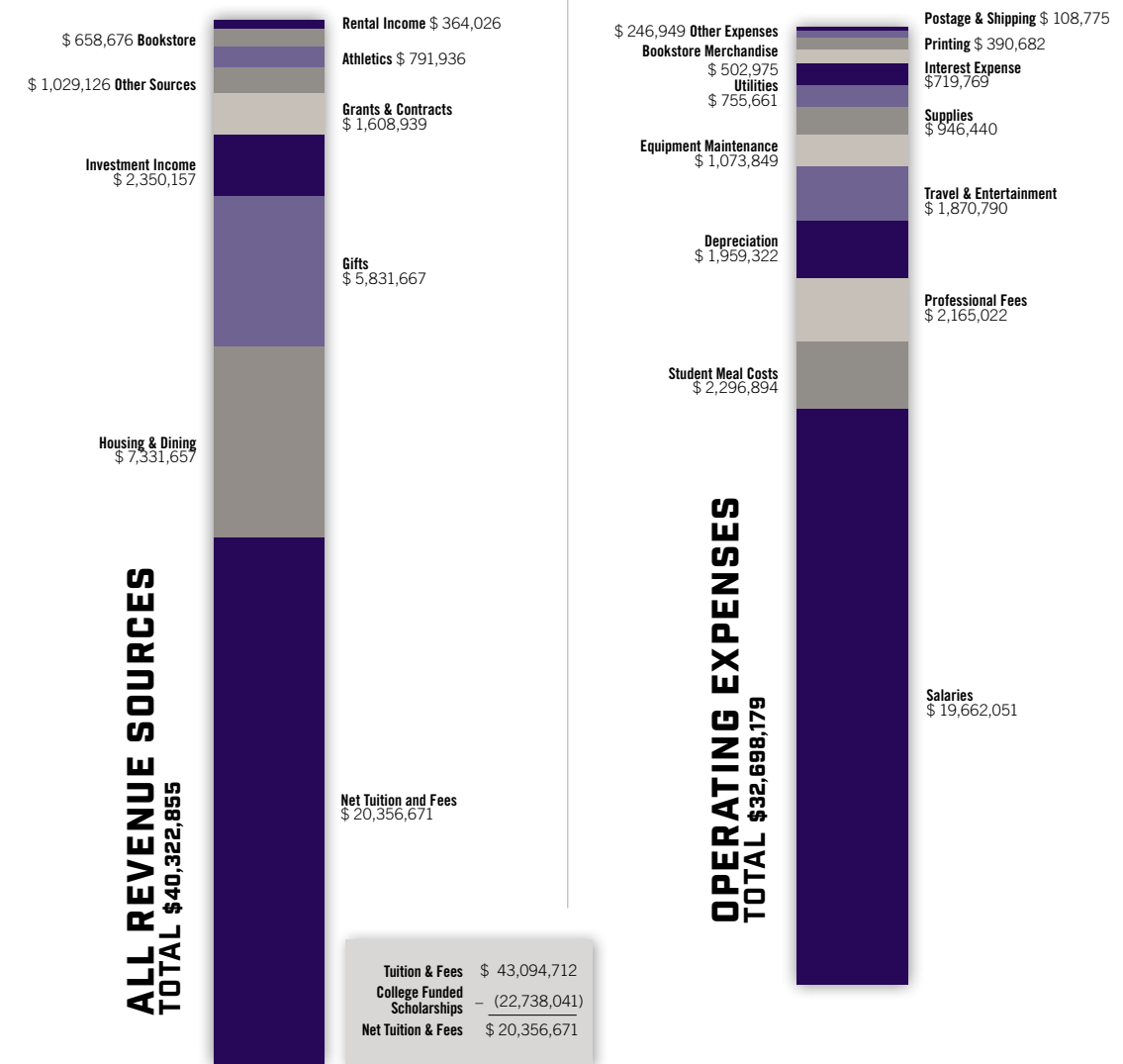

FINANCIAL OVERVIEW 2018-2019



In addition to recognizing the many individuals and businesses who have so generously supported our students and college, our 2018-2019 Annual Report provides a timeline of just some of the many achievements and accomplishments of our Carroll community from the past year.



HERE COMES THE SUN

Carroll is now home to the largest on-campus solar photovoltaic array in Montana after having received a \$48,000 incentive through NorthWestern Energy. The 38 kW solar array, which is installed on the south-facing roof of the Campus Center, will generate nearly \$6,000 worth of electricity annually, as well as provide student experiences in both interdisciplinary education and civic engagement.



CHARTING THE COURSE

The Health and Science Advisory Board was established to map out ways and means to maximize Carroll's ability to attract and retain top biomedical and health sciences students, and to provide the most effective launch for their graduate education and careers. One key area of interest identified at the first meeting and championed by Board members Russ Bell, PhD, (shown in photo above with students), Keith Hansen, MD, and Meg Hansen, PA-C, MPAS, was development of undergraduate research opportunities, critical to successful graduate school applications. Advisory Board members and affiliated Carroll faculty and staff raised over \$175,000, resulting in mentored undergraduate research opportunities, an endowed professorship, and scholarships.

FULLY ACCREDITED

After a lengthy and comprehensive review, Carroll College received formal notification from the Northwest Commission on Colleges and Universities that its accreditation was reaffirmed for another seven-year cycle. The NWCCU Commission applauded Carroll's thorough and multifaceted planning process including the recent program planning and prioritization effort, the college's enrollment planning, and its new core curriculum.

GIFT OF FLIGHT

Carroll's Engineers Without Borders Uganda program received a grant for ten round trip airlines tickets from Seattle to Entebbe, Uganda. This grant is from the Emirates Airlines Foundation, and is worth approximately \$18,000, the largest grant Carroll's EWB program has ever received. This will allow at least eight students and two mentors to travel to the Kwango Village near Nkozi to continue the important work they have begun in constructing a solar powered pump that will lead to a 10,000-gallon storage tank which will have gravity fed spigots located around the local Holy Trinity School and village area.

MAJOR MAKEOVER

In the summer of 2017, the PE Center underwent a number of improvements including a new athletic weight room, 12,000 square feet of maple flooring installed in the gym, a large new athletic classroom which doubles as event space, and a plaza area between the HAC and PE Center. PRESERVATION PERFECTION

All Saints Chapel was honored with a Lewis & Clark County Historic Preservation Award. Through the dedicated preservation work undertaken by CTA Architects, Dick Anderson Construction, and Fr. Marc Lenneman, the chapel was selected for the award for retaining both the historic character as well as many of the materials that existed with the construction of the original 1917 "Old North" gymnasium while also meeting the college's longtime need for a chapel that would accommodate over 400 worshippers.
