## **Schedule and Bracket Notes: (Remember this is just for fun)**

I did my best to fulfill everyone's request on times you could and could not play. Teams with players involved with the Spring Football Game were scheduled at Noon or after noon. I know the noon game will be tight, but it is the only way to get in all the games. We tried to make everything as random as possible while still creating pools that have alike teams that will enjoy playing one another.

## **Winning your pool to move on to the Playoffs** **(See Rules on Tie)**

**The team with the best record in each pool will move on to the Playoffs.**

**There are 8 pools and all teams will get to play 3 games. The Winner (best record) of each pool moves on to the playoffs (please see playoff schedule) In the event that two teams have a tie record in any one pool we will then look at the head to head score of those two teams. In the event that there are three teams tied at 2-2 we will look at the "runs difference"**

**The run difference is the number of runs you beat the other teams by.**

**For example, if you played 3 games and your record was 2 wins and 1 loss:**

**First Game – you won by a score of 21 to 5 and the 10-run rule came into effect in the 5<sup>th</sup> inning or even if you only played 4 innings you would be awarded the win by 10 runs. First game = 10**

**Second Game – you won by a score of 21 to 19 you would get 2 runs for that game.**

**Third Game – you lost by a score of 10 to 5 you would get - 5 runs (the other team gets 5)**

**Your Total would by "7" runs.**

**Drop Dead Rule with a 55 min time limit per game. - A horn will sound the start and the end of the game time. Games called on time will revert to the score at the last full inning completed. Unless the team that is batting second in the inning has a score that has tied or passed the team that batted first in the inning. If the game is tied when the horn sounds or when we revert to the top of the last completed inning then a tie score will be reported in the standings.**

**Scorecards will be in the dugouts... It is the responsibility of the umpire to bring the scorecard to Patrick Harris. We will use these scorecards to determine who moves forward to the Playoffs.**
